Dordon Parish Council has two parish councillor vacancies, and we are hoping you will join us.

Because the role of councillor is an elected office there are some statutory requirements that set out who can be elected. To be eligible for election you must:

- Be 18 years old or older.
- Be a British citizen.
- Live within a distance of 3 miles from the Dordon Parish Council boundary or your main place of work for previous 12 months must have been within the parish council boundary.
- You must not be employed by the parish.
- You must not be Bankrupt.
- You must not have served 3 months or more in prison during the last 5 years.
- You must not be disqualified under the Representation of the People Act 1983.

The closing date for the submission of applications is midday on Friday 2nd June 2023.
